WASHINGTON -- Thursday Congressman Tim Huelskamp voted to create a Select Committee to investigate the Benghazi terrorist attack in Libya. After its passage, Rep. Huelskamp released the following statement:

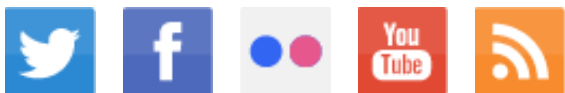
